## "FRESH THREADS - CONFIDENT KIDS" – Helping children to feel confident and ready to learn

Fresh Threads – Confident Kids collection drives aim to provide <u>NEW</u> socks, underwear, and sweatpants for children ages 3 to 8 who may face unexpected accidents during their school day, arrive at school in soiled clothing, or without appropriate attire. Having access to clean and dry clothing that fits is essential for preschoolers and students, as it directly impacts their confidence and ability to focus on their education or activities in the classroom.

When children come to school feeling uncomfortable or embarrassed, it can hinder their learning experience and self-esteem. By collecting these essentials, you can ensure that every child can participate fully in classroom activities without distraction or shame. The items collected will be distributed at the Strong Neighborhood Strong Families, partnering preschools and elementary schools.

## Items to collect:
